This four-year degree program presents concepts central to the traditional BBA and B.Com. degree programs in a global framework, strengthening their value to both students and employers. ### Industry Project

During your final semester, you'll gain further real world experience by collaborating with a local, internationally-operating company on an international business project. ### Cooperative Placement and Study Abroad

The program includes two, four-month paid co-op work placements at the end of both Term 6 and Term 7. These placements are excellent opportunities to use your newly acquired knowledge of global business management. In addition, in Year 3, you'll have the option to study for one semester at the Arnhem Business School in the Netherlands. This opportunity will build your understanding of international business from the European perspective.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent, including these required courses: One English, Grade 12 (ENG4U) plus one Mathematics, Grade 12 (U) plus four other Grade 12 subjects at the U or M level. A minimum grade of 65% is required in each course or two semesters of postsecondary education including required.
